Section 2: Election of officers. [Includehow officers are elected/ selected, method of nominations, and how balloting is used]. The Executive Board of the student organization must be elected in November or December for the following calendar year.

Section 3: Officers shall take office on the first day of classes of the spring semester and shall servefor a period of onefull academic year (two semesters).

Section 4: Officers shall not be on academic or university disciplinary probation at the time of their election and throughout their term in office.

Section 1: $\quad$ Officers failing to fulfill the given responsibilities and duties may be removed by the active organization.

Section 2: $\quad$ The removal of an officer requires a majority vote of [traditionally twothirds or three-quarters] organization members following notification of the officer in question. Such notification shall be provided in writing no
